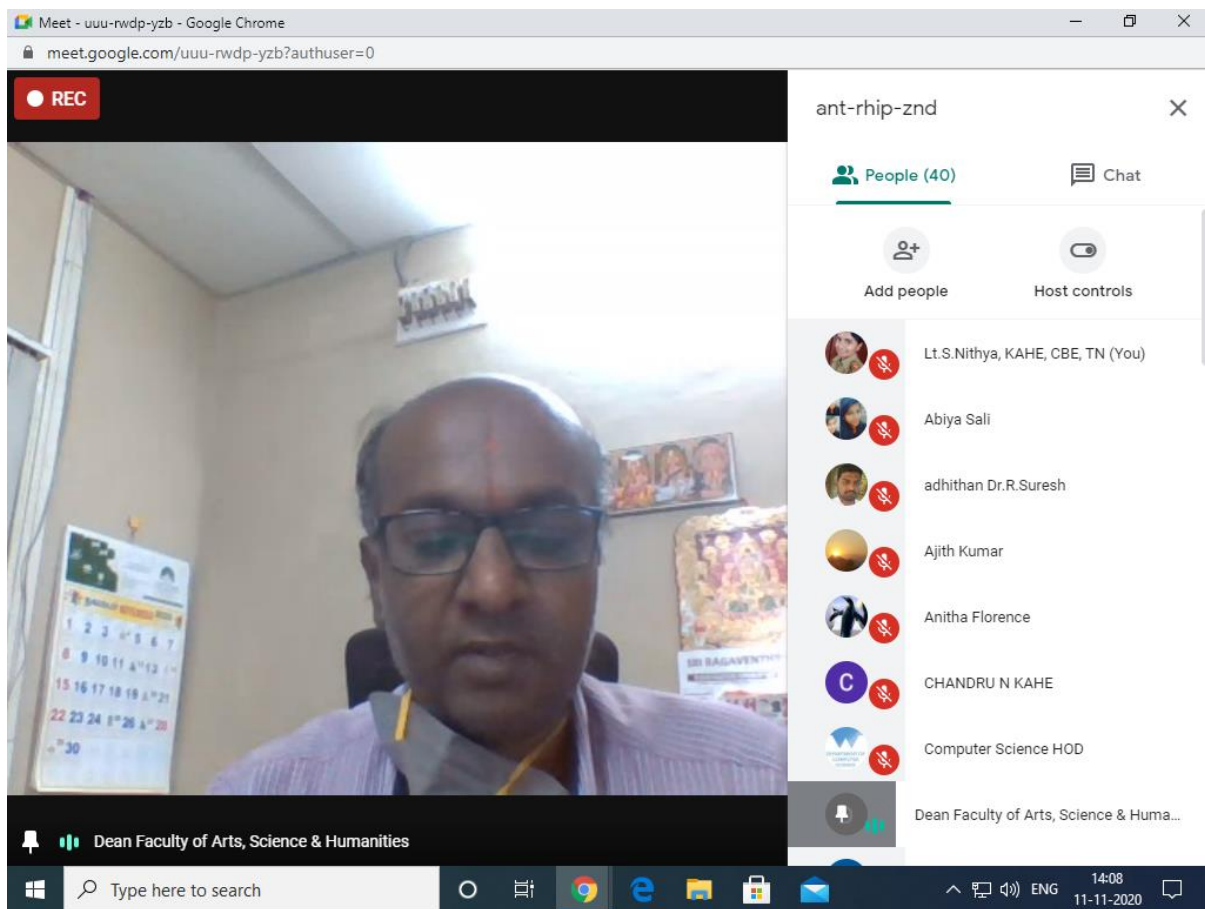

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
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

PRINCIPLES OF THIS POLICY

- The purpose of the education system is to develop good human beings capable of rational thought and action, possessing compassion and empathy, courage and resilience, scientific temper and creative imagination, with sound ethical moorings and values.
- It aims at producing engaged, productive, and contributing citizens for building an equitable, inclusive, and plural society as envisaged by our Constitution.
- A good education institution is one in which every student feels welcomed and cared for, where a safe and stimulating learning environment exists, where a wide range of learning experiences are offered, and where good physical infrastructure and appropriate resources conducive to learning are available to all students.

CAPACITY OF TEACHERS

- Teacher capacity also plays a central role in the attainment of foundational skills.
- Currently, few teachers have had the opportunity to be trained in a multilevel, play-based, student-centred style of learning that, according to extensive ECCE research, is so important for students in early grade school, particularly in Grades 1 and 2.
- A further factor in the crisis in many areas relates to teacher deployment.
- One aspect of teacher deployment (or lack thereof) which sometimes forms a barrier to play-based, multilevel, and individualized learning, is the PTR, which in some disadvantaged areas, often exceeds 30:1, making learning for all much more difficult in these areas.

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
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
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- Children learn languages, most quickly between 2-8 years, and multilingualism has great cognitive benefits for students. Therefore a three-language formula has been proposed.
- It proposes the teaching of other classical languages and literature, including Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Odia, Pali, Persian, and Prakrit in schools.
- Home language/mother tongue as medium of instruction and Exposure to three or more languages to students from pre-school and Grade 1 will be given.
- Major effort from both the Central and State governments to invest in large numbers of language teachers in all regional languages around the country, and in particular all Schedule 8 languages.
- The policy proposes three types of Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs): Research Universities, Teaching Universities and Autonomous degree-granting colleges
- It aims to provide autonomy to all higher education institutions. Higher education institutions to be governed by Independent Boards with complete academic and administrative autonomy

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


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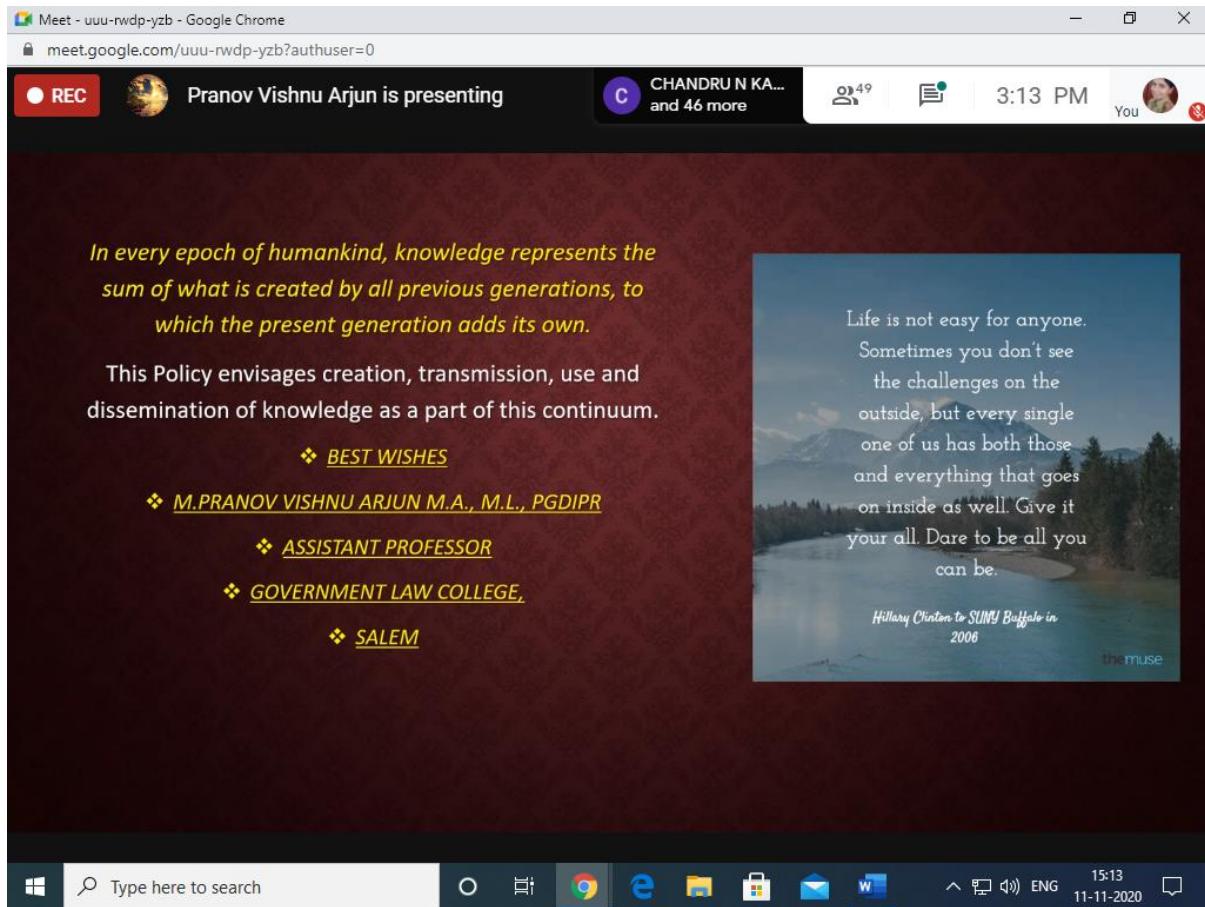
